In addition, the Access Center offers referral services, outreach assessments, and short-term treatment for individuals and families in crisis.</p>
<p>Entry Point Connections for the Homeless Lake Street Church 607 Lake Street Evanston, IL 60201</p>	<p>24-hour mobile response and assessment unit for homeless individuals in Evanston. Outreach services are provided to identify and work with people wherever they might be identified to provide resource information and assistance in gaining access to necessary services.</p>
<p>The Harbour, Inc. Emergency Shelter 1480 Renaissance Drive Park Ridge, IL 60068</p>	<p>The Harbour Shelter provides temporary shelter care to female adolescents who are experiencing a personal or family crisis and unable to stay in their current housing arrangement. They are provided with intensive crisis intervention counseling services and support to reunite with their families or develop other appropriate long-term care arrangements.</p> <p>The Harbour also operates a single apartment unit in Evanston for 3 older adolescent females who are not able to live with their families. In addition to housing, the agency provides supportive services and life skills training to enable the young women to prepare for independent living.</p>
<p>Trilogy/Evanston Emergency Mental Health Services ( 800-322-8400) 1618 Orrington Avenue Suite 203 Evanston, IL 60201</p>	<p>This is a 24-hour/7 day-a-week crisis telephone line for Evanston residents. EMHS provides counseling, either by telephone or in-person, for mental health issues. When necessary, EMHS can provide face to face psychiatric assessment and assistance. The staff can meet the caller at home or in some other agreeable site to discuss intervention options. When a problem requires the help of other professionals, the staff can refer the caller to those services. If necessary, transportation can be arranged for the caller to reach hospitals or other crisis services.</p>

<p>Alden Estates of Evanston 2520 Gross Pointe Road Wilmette, IL 60091</p>	<p>A long-term care facility that provides skilled and sheltered care. Licensed for 99 beds. Medicare, Medicaid and Private pay.</p>

Dobson Plaza Nursing Home 120 Dodge Avenue Evanston, IL 60202	A Long-term care facility that provides skilled and intermediate care. Licensed for 96 beds. Medicaid, Medicare and Private pay.
Ebenezer Primm Towers 1001 Emerson Street Evanston, IL 60201	100 subsidized studio and one bedroom apartments. Tenants must be 62 years of age. Rents are subsidized through Section 202 Program.
CEDA/Evanston Neighbors at Work 1229 Emerson Street Evanston, IL 60201	Provides general services and assistance to seniors to find low-cost housing. CEDA also operates a minor home repair and weatherization program and a handyman program for older adults, in conjunction with the commission on aging. There are no fees for most services.
Council for Jewish Elderly 3003 W Touhy Ave. Chicago, Illinois 60645	The program provides a continuum of health care and social services to bridge the gap between institutionalization and the community, allowing seniors to live at home while receiving health, social, recreational and/or rehabilitative services. Services include case management and counseling, subsidized housing, long term care facilities, adult day program services, home delivered meals and in home caregivers.
Housing Authority of Cook County/Local Office 1123 Emerson Street Evanston, IL 60201	Sponsors two senior housing apartment buildings for residents who are at least 62 years old or have a disability. Rent is subsidized, limited to low-income individuals or couples. Sponsors Section 8 Program throughout the community
Interfaith Housing Center of Northern Suburbs 620 Lincoln Winnetka, IL 60093	Provides assistance in securing appropriate, affordable housing. The organization operates a home-sharing program that helps to "match" compatible individuals seeking to share housing. The organization also provides housing counseling and assists persons who have been the victims of predatory loans.
Three Crowns Park 2323 McDaniel Evanston, IL 60201	A long-term care facility that provides skilled and intermediate care and assisted living services. 130 Units, of which 48 are licensed for skilled and intermediate care. Private pay.
North Shore Retirement Hotel 1611 Chicago Avenue Evanston, IL 60201	Operates as a full service retirement hotel. Offers studio and one-bedroom units. Services include meals, activities and daily housekeeping. Additional support services are available on a fee for service basis. Residents must be ambulatory and in good health on admission. 215 Units. Private pay. Some rents are subsidized through the Section 8 Program.
Walchirk Apts. 2300 Noyes Court Evanston, IL 60201	100 subsidized studio and one-bedroom apartments. Tenants must be 62 years of age or have a disability. Rents are subsidized through the Section 8 Program.
Oakwood Terrace Inc. 1300 Oak Avenue Evanston, IL 60201	Operates as an intermediate and skilled care facility. 57 units. Medicare, Medicaid and Private pay.
St. Francis Nursing and Rehabilitation Center 500 Asbury Evanston, IL 60202	Operates as a long-term care facility that provides intermediate and skilled nursing care. 124 Beds. Medicare, Medicaid and Private pay.
Perlman Apartments 1900 Sherman Evanston, IL 60201	100 subsidized studio and one-bedroom apartments. Tenants must be 62 years of age or have a disability. Rents are subsidized through the Section 8 Program.
Mather Place at The Georgian 422 Davis Street Evanston, IL 60201	An independent living facility for adults 65 and older who on admission must be ambulatory and in good health. 107 units. Part of Mather LifeWays. Private pay.
Mather Gardens 1615 Hinman Avenue Evanston, IL 60201	An Assisted Living establishment that provides supportive services. 110 units. Part of Mather LifeWays. Private pay.

Mather Pavilion at Wagner 820 Foster Evanston, IL 60201	A long-term care facility that provides intermediate and skilled nursing care. 190 units. Part of Mather LifeWays. Medicare and private pay.
The Highlands of Evanston 3200 Grant Evanston, IL 60201	110 Assisted Living apartments that offer supportive services. A part of the Presbyterian Homes. Private pay.
The King Home 1555 Oak Avenue Evanston, IL 60201	An intermediate care facility for men over 65. 18 intermediate care beds. The facility also has 90 sheltered-care units for persons who can perform all activities of daily living and care for their own health needs. A part of the Presbyterian Homes. Private pay.

Links consumers with the services they need. Pre-admission screening for residential services and nursing homes for persons who have a developmental disability
Child and Family Connections 1835 W. Central Road Arlington Heights, IL 60008	Regional agency that implements state mandates in providing referrals evaluations and assessments, and service coordination for individuals and toddlers from birth to 36 months of age who are experiencing developmental delays or have a diagnosed physical or mental condition that has a high probability of resulting in a developmental delay.
District #65 Services for Pre-Primary Age Children 828 Main Evanston, IL 60202	Screening, diagnosis and intervention for 3 to 5 year old children.
Epilepsy Services for Northeastern Illinois 1698 First Street Highland Park, IL 60035	Provides a wide range of professional social services and case management peer support to persons with epilepsy.
Rimland NFP, Inc. 1265 Hartrey Evanston, IL 60202	Rimland offers a behavioral treatment program for children and young adults with autism. They operates four residential living arrangements Evanston. Children participate in the agency's educational program. Clients in the adult program also participate in a sheltered workshop program.
SHORE: Community Services for Retarded Citizens 4232 Dempster Street Skokie, IL 60076	Supervised living settings are provided for adults with developmental disabilities to develop daily living skills, increased independence and more normalized lifestyles.

	Supervision, guidance and training is provided as needed to help residents learn basic self care, activities of daily living, and social skills.
	Vocational evaluation, training, job placement, supported employment and long term sheltered employment are provided for adults with developmental disabilities. Supportive therapy services are provided for trainees and their families as needed.
CHILD Program Clearbrook Center 3705 Pheasant Drive Rolling Meadows, IL 60008	Regional provider for a comprehensive Early Intervention Program for families with children under the age of 3 who have a disability. Physical, occupational and speech therapy are part of the program. In-home respite relief is also provided for those families who need a respite relief in their role as caregiver. Respite can be provided for up to four hours a week by a specially trained volunteer.

Case management services are provided for Evanston residents with mental illness, including assessments, service linkage and monitoring treatment progress or medication compliance. Outpatient psychotherapy and psychopharmacologic services are also provided. A long-term, partial hospitalization program is provided for people with chronic psychiatric problems as an alternative to hospitalization.</p> <p>The Access Center provides a 24-hour suicide prevention hotline and emergency room psychiatric crisis services. In addition, the Access Center offers referral services, outreach assessments, and short-term treatment for individuals and families in crisis.</p> <p>Inpatient treatment for individuals in need of a supportive or protective environment including medical and psychological evaluation, family assessment and therapy, individual and milieu psychotherapy, medication, or other schematic therapies.</p> <p>The program provides assistance to adults with psychiatric disabilities to plan and prepare for the following areas: employment, supported housing, education, and welfare.</p>

<p>Resurrection Health Care-St Francis Hospital/Dept. of Behavioral Health  355 Ridge Avenue  Evanston, IL 60202</p>	<p>The agency provides individual, couple and family therapy to the identified client and their families. Issues may include depression, phobia, behavioral problems, family problems, single-parent issues and support for persons with developmental disabilities. Group therapy is available to a variety of clients i.e. anger management, chronic pain, self esteem. The agency also has a full spectrum of services for people struggling with chemical dependency issues. Assessment, treatment and education are provided to all whom are affected. A Partial Hospitalization Program offers services for adults who experience personality disorders, anxiety or depression in lieu of inpatient services. Aftercare services are provided for individuals who have been hospitalized to assist in their readjustment to the community, and to provide medication when necessary.</p>

<p>Greenwood Care Inc. 1406 Chicago Ave. Evanston, IL 60201</p>	<p>An intermediate care, psychiatric rehabilitation service facility-24-hour nursing care, medication monitoring psychosocial, ADL and life skills training groups, medical director, psychiatrist consultants, full-time Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services Coordinators (PRSC), certified therapeutic recreation specialist, 3 meals a day, laundry facilities and housekeeping services.</p>
<p>Housing Options Evanston, IL</p>	<p>Housing Options creates affordable housing with supportive services to enable adults with severe and persistent mental illness to live as independently as possible. The agency provides permanent housing with on-site staff for low-income adults. Intensive case management services are provided to assist the individuals to avoid rehospitalization and maintain permanent housing in the community. Some of the housing units are dedicated for persons who are homeless. The SHIP Program provides transitional housing and support services for the same population, and provides a directory of housing resources for individuals who need low-cost housing options.</p> <p>Housing Options also developed a program of permanent housing with supportive mental health treatment for individuals who are currently homeless and have a mental illness. The program targets a population that does not participate in traditional mental health services. The range of services includes assessments of the resident's community living skills with training and services to address skill deficits, evaluation and treatment by a psychiatrist, and case management services to help residents to use community services such as medical clinics and disability entitlements.</p>

The Case Manager provides an assessment of the person's immediate needs and develops an individual goal plan. As needed, an individual may be placed in a detox or residential treatment programs. Follow-up is provided to assist the individual to complete their goal plans. Assistance is also provided to place individuals in halfway houses, transitional housing, and jobs. Support meetings are provided about substance abuse and recovery. The individual is also aided in finding AA sponsors and attending AA meetings. These services are also provided to recent graduates of the homeless shelter.
Dimensions: Dual Diagnosis Treatment a collaborative project of: PEER Services, Inc.,; Resurrection Health Care-St Francis Hospital/Dept. of Behavioral Health; and Connections for the Homeless	Dimensions provides integrated treatment to simultaneously address both the mental health and substance abuse recovery needs of Evanston residents who are living with dual disorders. Program services include: groups; treatment planning; Weekly individual therapy and case management; drug testing; weekly medical and clinical staffing and case evaluation; daily community meals; psychiatric consultation and medication management; health screening and consultation; on-site 12 step meeting; and outreach and case management services. Targeted case management services are provided for individuals who are homeless and participating at the homeless shelter.
