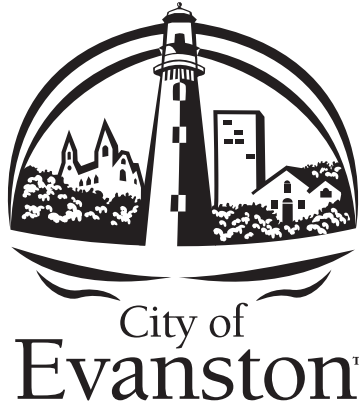

Evanston Neighborhood Security Program

The City of Evanston offers the Evanston Neighborhood Security Program to property owners of multi-unit residential buildings. Depending on building size, owners may be eligible for a 50% rebate of as much as \$1,500 of the cost for installation or upgrades to security features on their building and surrounding property. The program emphasizes overall external building security and promotes security improvements associated with a building's surroundings (courtyard, alley, sideyard, etc.) and building access (vestibule, stairwells, and garages, etc.). Eligible improvements could include such things as new or improved outdoor lighting, vestibule locking mechanisms, video security, exterior stairwell enclosures, etc. Improvements to individual units are not eligible under this program.

Program Guidelines

- Area Boundaries:** CDBG Target Area (see map on back)
- Eligible Applicants:** Owners of multi-unit residential buildings
- Benefit:** Rebate of up to 50% of the cost of installation of approved security features with a maximum of: \$750 for buildings of 2-3 units; \$1,000, for buildings of 4-8 units; and \$1,500 for buildings over 8 units.
- Process:**
1. Owner must make written application to the program and agree to follow all applicable regulations of the City of Evanston and its Community Development Block Grant Program.
 2. The Police Department must conduct a Building Security Survey.
 3. Final City of Evanston approval will be issued based on results and recommended specifications of the Police Building Security Survey and must be obtained prior to installation of any improvements. Applicants cannot begin work until Building Security Survey is completed and Letter of Approval is issued.
 4. Rebates will be issued upon final inspection by the Police Department and proof of payment for materials and labor associated with approved security features.

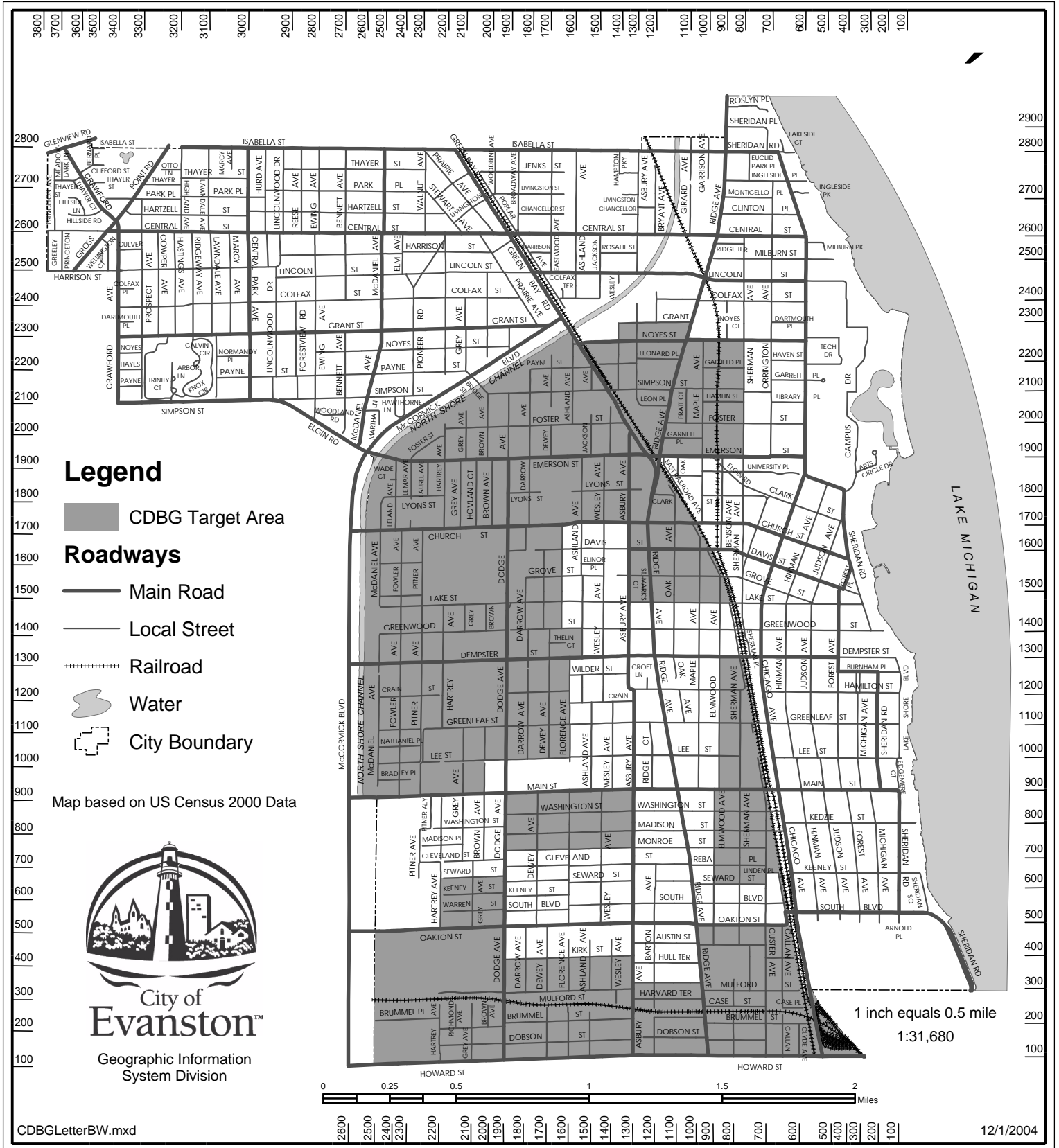
