## CRIME ALERT – Residential and Storage Burglaries in Police Beat 78

The Evanston Police Department is currently investigating reports of residential burglaries on the southeast end of the city:

| <b>Burglary-Storage area</b>       | 960 Dobson between 11/16/07 at 1830 hrs and 11/17/07 at 0626 hrs. Unknown subject(s) gained entry to a laundry/storage area and removed a purple/pink bicycle, a grey Cannondale bicycle, and coins from the washers and dryers. 07-38156; 07-38159; 07-38160 |
| <b>Burglary-Storage area</b>       | 733 Brummel between 11/15/07 at 1900 hrs and 11/16/07 at 1900 hrs. Unknown subject(s) used a pry tool to gain entry to a laundry/storage area and removed a black Trek bicycle. 07-38179  |
| <b>Burglary-RE</b>                 | 823 Dobson on 11/19/07 between 0830 hrs and 1518 hrs. Unknown subject(s) gained entry to the apartment by forcing open a rear door. The subject(s) ransacked the interior and removed DVDs and a backpack. 07-38387   |
| <b>Burglary-Residential</b>        | 823 Dobson between 11/19/07 at 2000 hrs and 11/21/07 at 1830 hrs. Unknown subject(s) gained entry to the apartment via unknown means and took a DVD player, DVDs and food items. 07-38543   |
| <b>Burglary-Residential (Att.)</b> | 229 Custer on 11/20/07 at 1041 hrs. Two unknown subjects (#1 M/B, dark complexion, 5'08", 150 lbs, 30s, #2 F/B, 5'02", 180 lbs, 30s) attempted to gain entry to a gated area. The subjects fled on foot. 07-38493   |
| <b>Burglary-Residential</b>        | 116 Clyde on 11/25/07 between 1300 hrs and 1700 hrs. Unknown subject(s) gained entry to the residence by forcing the rear door, and then removed jewelry. 07-38927  |
| <b>Burglary-Residential</b>        | 120 Clyde on 11/21/07 between 1200 hrs and 1600 hrs. Unknown subject(s) gained entry to the residence by using a pry tool on the rear door, and then removed two computers, two MP3 players, and USC. 07-38613  |
| <b>Burglary-Storage area</b>       | 612 Mulford between 11/17/07 at 0600 hrs and 11/21/07 at 2100 hrs. Unknown subject(s) gained entry to the storage locker by using a pry tool and removed two bicycles. 07-38636   |
| <b>Burglary-Storage area</b>       | 812 Brummel reported on 11/20/07 at 2230 hrs. Unknown subject(s) defeated the padlock on the storage unit and ransacked the interior. 07-38585  |
| <b>Burglary-Storage area</b>       | 810 Brummel reported on 11/20/07 at 2230 hrs. Unknown subject(s) used a pry tool to defeat the lock on a basement storage unit and ransacked the interior. 07-38579   |
| <b>Burglary-Residential (Att.)</b> | 823 Dobson between 11/21/07 at 2100 hrs and 11/22/07 at 0900 hrs. Unknown subject(s) used a pry tool to gain entry to the residence. Nothing appeared to be missing. 07-39008   |
