III. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

(H1) **Township of Evanston Monthly Bills**

Consideration to approve the Township of Evanston April 2008 bills totaling \$91,530.31

(H2) **Ordinance 56-O-08 Amending Title 3, Chapter 16 of the City Code “Cigarettes and Tobacco Products” by Adding Section 3-16-13 “Sale of Improperly Packaged Tobacco Products Prohibited”**

Consideration to prohibit the sale of improperly packaged tobacco including the sale of individual cigarettes known as “loosies”.

(H3) **Resolution 25-R-08 Calling for Opposition to U.S. Military Intervention or Use of Force in Iran**

Consideration of Resolution 25-R-08 to urge congressional representatives not to launch military operations against Iran, to enact a congressional action to prevent funding for any military operation, to pressure the Administration and the next Administration to negotiate with Iran without the threat of military action, to maintain pressure against any escalation of the Iraq war.

(H4) **Ordinance 3-O-08 Amending the City Code by Enacting a New Title 9, Chapter 5, Section 32 “Fighting”**

Consideration of Ordinance 3-O-08 to prohibit any person to intentionally, knowingly or recklessly fight or brawl with another, for any person to permit any of the above acts in any house or upon any premises under the person management or control, a person charged with a violation was not the instigator and doesn't apply to persons engaged in amateur or professional fights licensed by the state. Any person violating this section shall be fined not less than \$100, nor more than \$750.00.

(H5) **Ordinance 50-O-08 Amending Various Sections of Title 9, Chapter 4 of the Evanston City Code, “Dogs, Cats, Animals and Fowl”**

Consideration of Ordinance 50-O-08 to require pen or structure to have a concrete bottom, require insurance policy to be separate from homeowners, dangerous dogs to be spayed/neutered and microchip at the owner's expense and limit the time to 10 days to file a written request for appeal. State Law has changed and if an animal is not current on rabies shot the law now requires a mandatory ten (10) day impoundment at a licensed vet.

(H6) **Consideration of Ordinance 43-O-08 Proposed Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Town Purposes, for Year Ending March 31, 2009**

Consideration of Ordinance 43-O-08 to approve the proposed Township of Evanston budget ending March 31, 2009. The budget was presented April 7, 2008, the Township Supervisor's and General Assistance Budget were approved, the Assessors Office Budget was held in committee. The Assessor's office has amended their proposed budget.

(H7) **Update of Citizen Police Advisory Committee**

Consideration for Mayoral appointment for the nine-person CPAC panel. Consideration of this proposal to authorize the appointments and term of service for all Advisory Committee members.
