2026 Sidewalk Improvement Program

July 21, 2026

Description

Over the next four to six weeks, sidewalk improvements will take place at various locations throughout the City as part of the 2026 Sidewalk Improvement Program. The work includes tree root pruning, where necessary, and the removal and replacement of sidewalks that meet the Program's criteria for replacement. The City is currently in Phase 1 of the Program, which focuses on sidewalks along school walk routes and near senior living facilities. A map of the 2026 Phase 1 project locations is attached.

In addition to the primary project locations shown on the attached map, work will also occur at approved properties participating in the City's 50/50 Sidewalk Replacement Program throughout the City.

Schedule

The project is anticipated to begin on July 23 and be completed by August 21, weather permitting. Work at each location will typically be performed in stages, beginning with root pruning where required, followed by sidewalk removals, framing, concrete placement, and final finishing. The exact dates that construction activities are scheduled to begin at each location will be noted on temporary construction zone "No Parking" signs posted a minimum of 48 hours in advance of the work. Every effort will be made to complete the work in a timely manner to minimize inconveniences caused by construction.

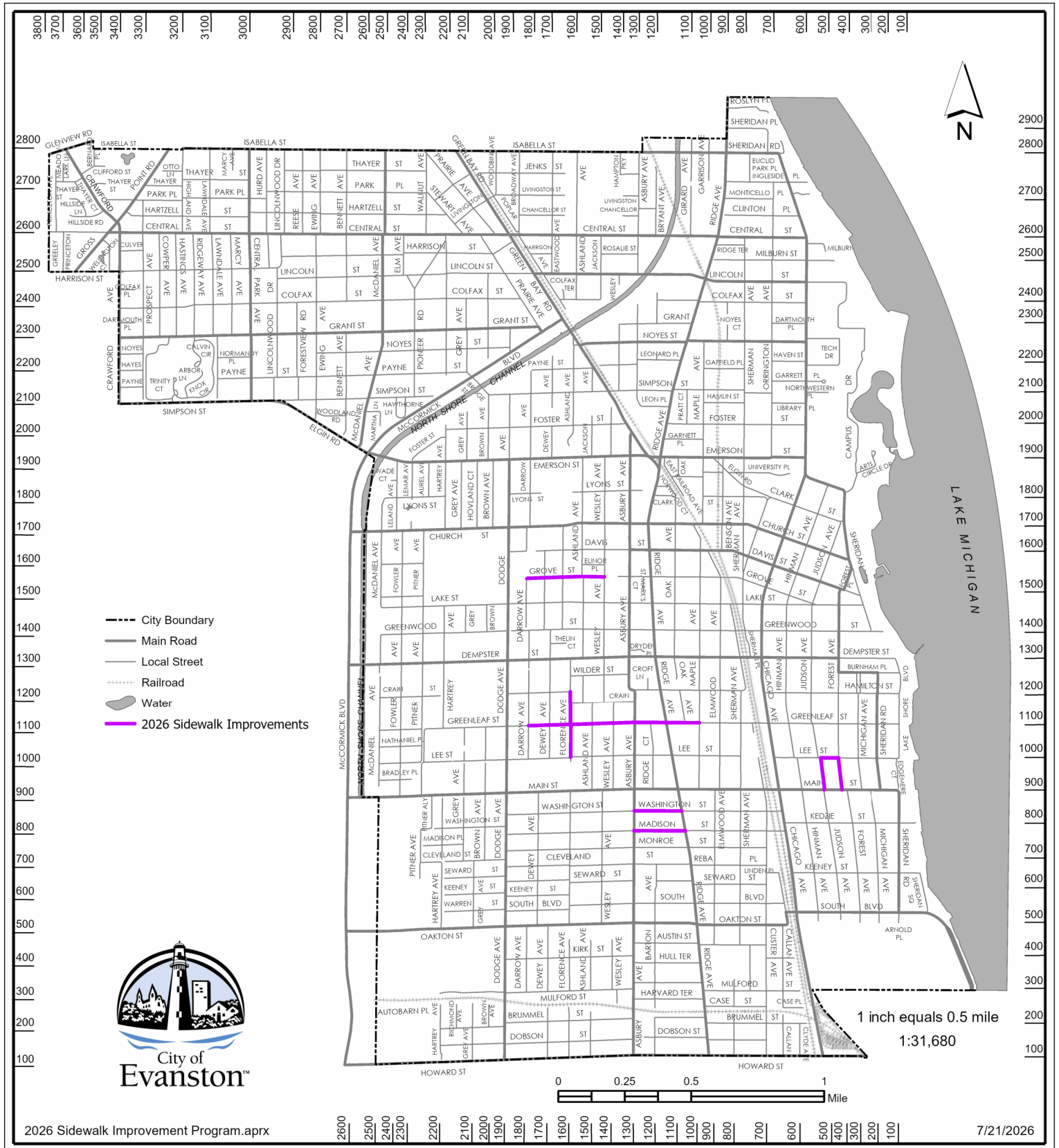
Contractor
