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## 2026 Lead Service Line Replacement Project

*September 4, 2026*

### Project Description

Work on the 2026 Lead Service Line Replacement Project will begin this fall and conclude next summer. The project includes water main replacements and lead service line replacements (LSLR) at the following 17 locations listed below and shown on the attached map.

#### **Water Main and LSLR**

Darrow (Lyons to Payne)  
Lyons (Dodge to Darrow)  
Dewey (Emerson to Foster)  
Foster (Grey to Hartrey)  
Grey (Emerson to North End)  
Ashland (Simpson to Noyes)  
Jackson (Emerson to Simpson)  
Wesley (Emerson to North End)

#### **LSLR Only (Standalone)**

Asbury (Emerson to Green Bay)  
Emerson (Dodge to Ashland)  
Emerson (Asbury to Green Bay)  
Foster (Grey to Green Bay)  
Fowler (Church to Lake)  
Green Bay (Emerson to Noyes)  
Jackson (Simpson to Green Bay)  
McDaniel (Church to Lake Street)  
Payne (Darrow to Green Bay)

This work involves replacement of deteriorated water mains, water service line replacement, minor sewer improvements, concrete curb and sidewalk repairs as needed, trench patching, street resurfacing, and parkway restoration. This project will also include the replacement of lead service lines into the homes of participating property owners that have signed a right-of-entry form. If a

property owner has declined to participate, the water service line will be replaced up to the parkway and a waiver will be requested and submitted to the Illinois Department of Public Health..

## **Project Schedule**

The project is anticipated to begin the week of September 14th and is scheduled to conclude by July 2027. The first phase of the work will be on Lyons east of Dodge to Darrow, then continue along Darrow up north to Payne. The exact dates of construction activities at each location will be noted on temporary construction zone “No Parking” signs posted a minimum of 48 hours in advance of the work. Street sweeping parking restrictions will be waived for a one block radius around the construction zone when temporary no parking is in effect. Every effort will be made to complete the work in a timely manner to minimize any inconveniences caused by the construction.

Property owners who have a signed right-of-entry form will be contacted by a representative of the contractor to schedule the lead service line replacement to the home once work commences on the block.

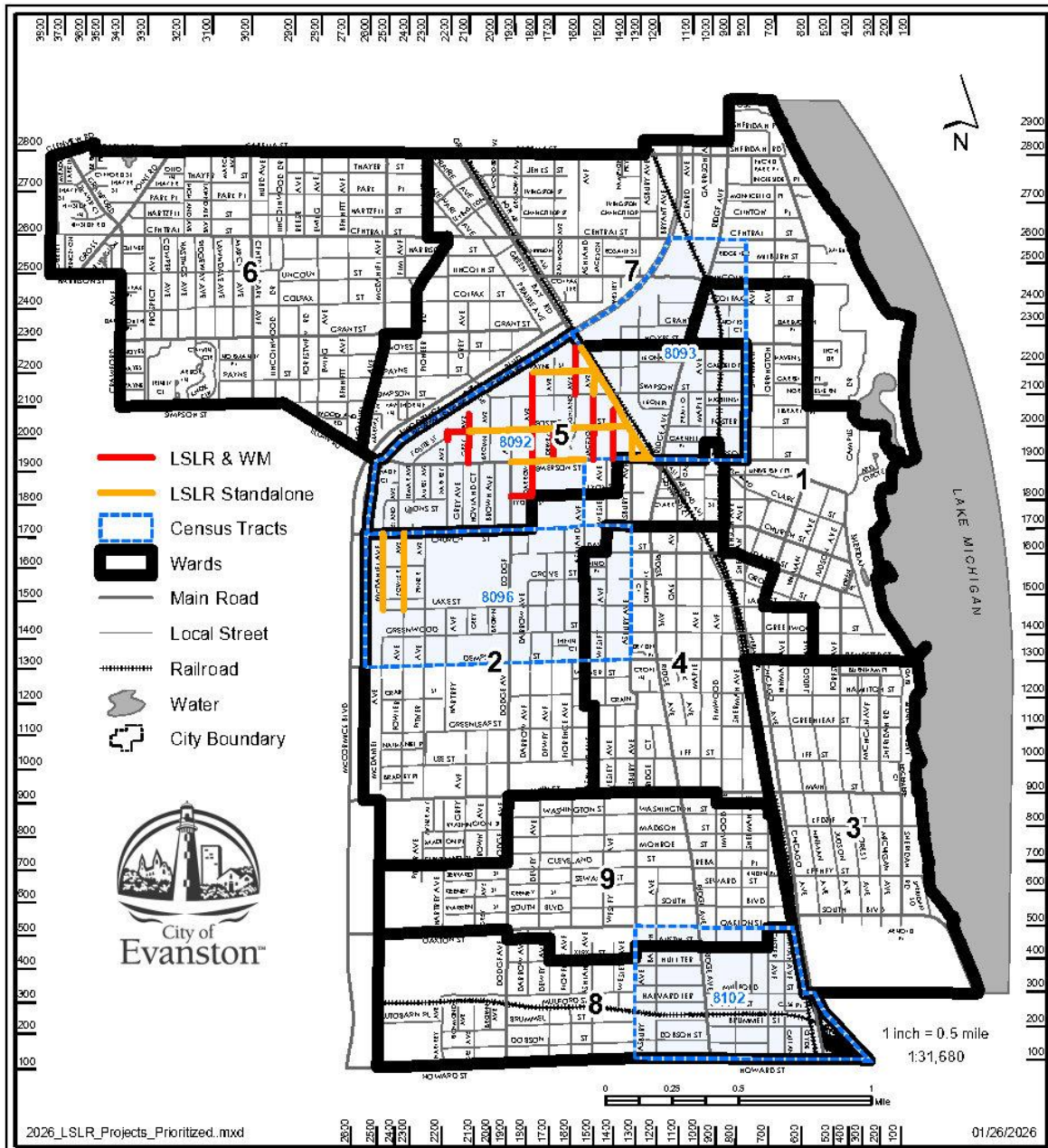
