Public Engagement meeting #2 was held at the Lincoln Elementary School.

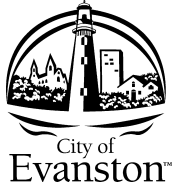
Staff went through the planned presentation, detailing project timelines, anticipated scope, existing conditions, and the two refined concepts. These concepts were refined from previous comments and voting at public meeting #1. Both concepts featured the same color scheme that was selected from the previous meeting. Also discussed were the addition of amenities, including the fence repair and new gate additions along the West side of the park.

Following this presentation, Staff opened the conversation to allow for open discussion and general questions/answers. Attendees had various comments and questions as listed below.

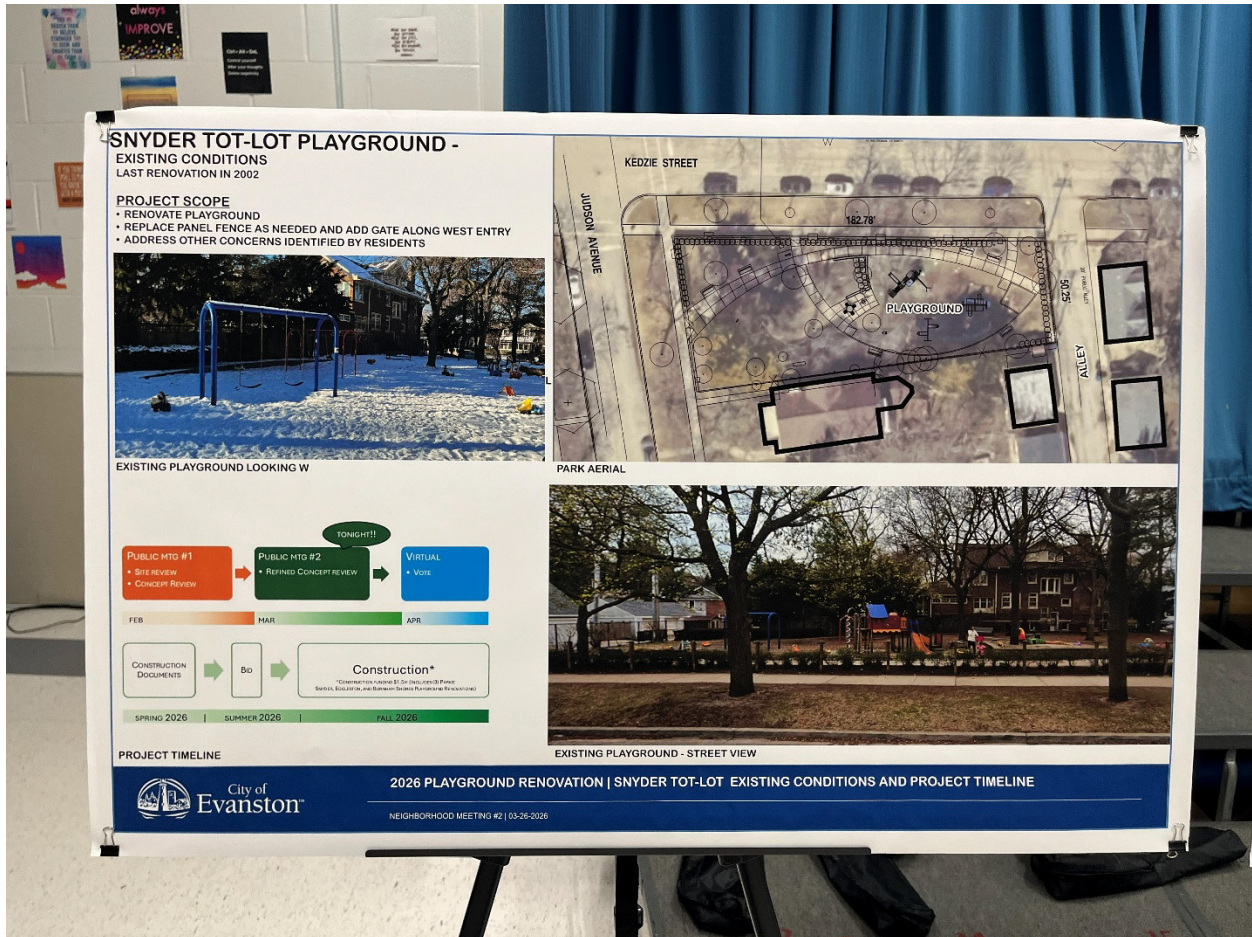


Image 1: Presentation board illustrating existing conditions and the project timeline.

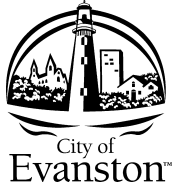


Image 2: Presentation board illustrating proposed amenities, fence repair/extension, and color selections from the previous public meeting.

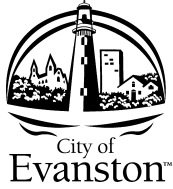
Image 3: Presentation board illustrating playground option 1, titled Imagination Grove. The board features the plan view as well as key plan updates and select renderings.
