Pavement Patching Program

April 27, 2026

Description

The City of Evanston has contracted pavement patch work on areas of asphalt throughout Evanston to begin the week of April 27th, weather permitting.

The Pavement Patching Program is an annual program that typically involves removing the top two inches of compromised surface and replacing it with new, compacted hot asphalt. Road locations with a considerable level of surface deterioration, while still maintaining effective functionality, such as adequate drainage, are targeted for this program. Once the asphalt is laid, compacted, and cooled, the street will be opened and ready for traffic. This work is anticipated to improve the condition of approximately 31,000 square yards of pavement with over 500 locations across the city.

During construction, motorists should expect minor delays near work zones as flaggers route traffic around the work crews. “No Parking” restrictions for this project should be short-term and specific to the daily work zones. “No Parking” signs will be posted 48 hours in advance of work and will be removed upon completion.

The contractor for this project is Chicagoland Paving Contractors, 225 Tesler Road, Lake Zurich, Illinois 60047. The contractor is contractually responsible for the means and methods of the work.

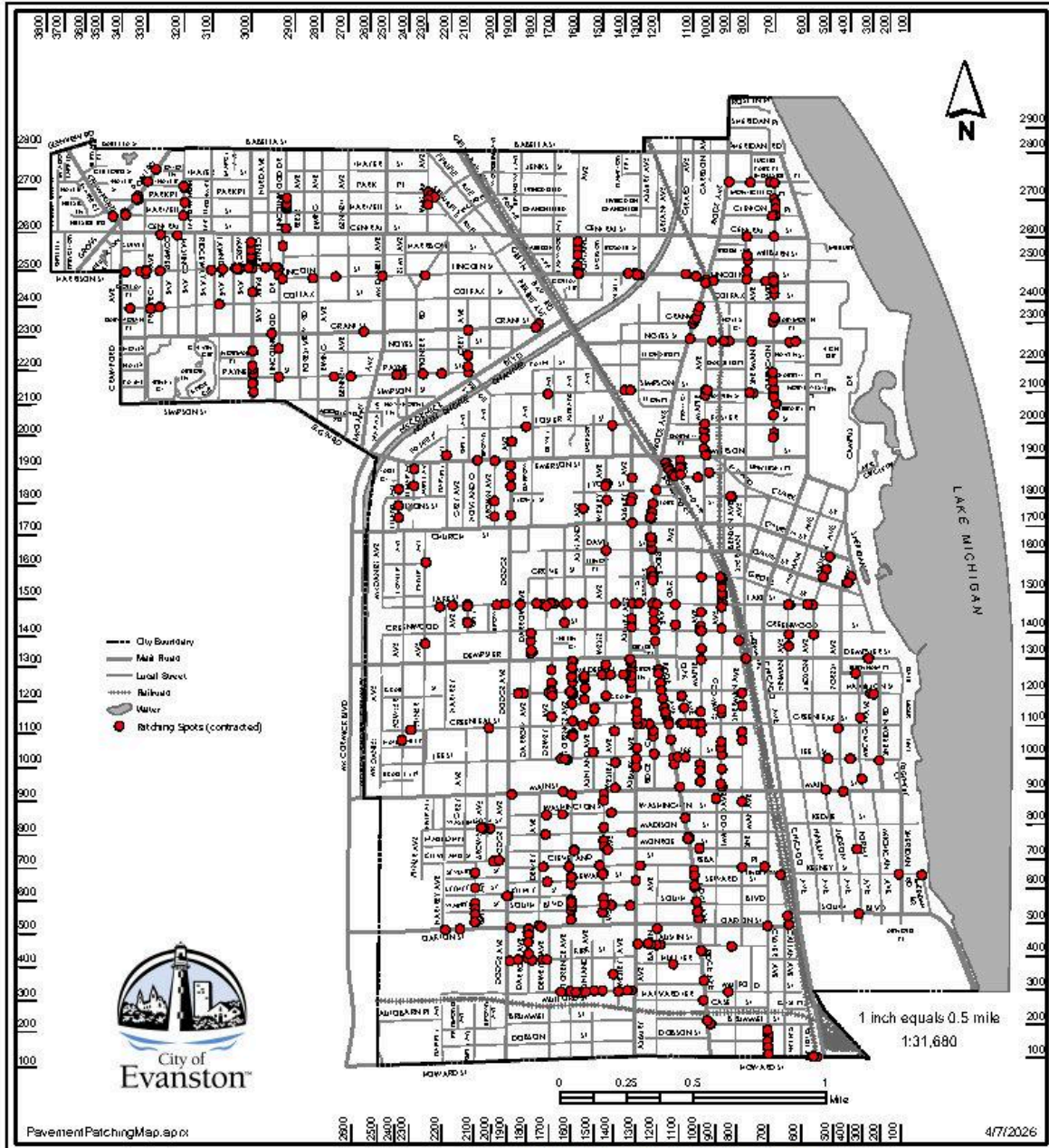
