Road Striping Program 2026

July 22, 2026

Description

The City's 2026 road striping program will begin on Friday July 24, 2026 at various locations, starting on Ridge Street, to refresh street markings for enhanced visibility and public safety. The re-striping process is conducted as a continuous mobile operation using specialized striping trucks that utilize rolling, intermittent lane closures to keep traffic moving with minimal disruption. As the convoy moves along the roadway, contractors clear loose debris from the surface, spray high-durability traffic paint to restore clean lines, and immediately coat the wet paint with reflective glass beads to ensure nighttime visibility. With a fast curing time of just 3 to 5 minutes, normal traffic flow resumes shortly after the work vehicle passes.

Schedule

Work is scheduled to begin on Friday, July 24, 2026, and is anticipated to take approximately one month. Operations will occur intermittently during this timeframe and remain weather-dependent. To minimize the need for temporary "No Parking" restrictions, specific work dates for each location will be scheduled around local parking availability. If these locations need to be posted they will be posted within 48 hours of work being done.
