Sidewalk Gap Infill Project (Dewey Ave from Howard St to Dobson St)

August 13, 2026

Project Description

As part of the 2026 Sidewalk Gap Infill and Sidewalk Replacement Program, construction is expected to begin within the next few weeks and is anticipated to take several weeks to complete, weather permitting. This phase of the project includes the installation of new ADA-compliant sidewalks to close existing sidewalk gaps along Dewey Avenue between Howard Street and Dobson Street. These improvements will enhance pedestrian connectivity, improve accessibility for individuals of all abilities, and provide a safer, more continuous walking route for residents, students, and visitors. Throughout various phases of construction, temporary parking restrictions will be necessary to accommodate construction activities, including contractor mobilization, equipment operation, and vehicle/material storage. While the City and contractor will make every effort to minimize impacts and restore parking availability as quickly as possible, residents should anticipate that parking immediately along this block will be restricted during active construction operations. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as these improvements are completed and work to enhance pedestrian safety and accessibility within the community.

Project Schedule

Work is anticipated to begin in the coming weeks and continue for approximately two to three weeks, weather permitting. Every effort will be made to complete the work in a timely manner to minimize inconveniences caused by construction. Parking will be prohibited during daytime work hours (7:00

AM to 5:00 PM) while construction takes place. Street sweeping parking restrictions will be waived for a one block radius around the construction zone when temporary daytime no parking is in effect. Every effort will be made to complete the work in a timely manner to minimize any inconveniences caused by the construction.
