



## Public Information Meeting Meeting Summary

A Public Information Meeting for the Church Street Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements Phase I Study was held on July 27, 2021 from 4 P.M. to 7 P.M. at the Evanston Ecology Center in Evanston, Illinois. The purpose of the meeting was to present the existing conditions and potential improvement alternatives and to accept public comments regarding the project. The meeting was conducted in an open house format with exhibits on display for review. Attendees had the opportunity to speak with study team representatives and provide written comments on the preferred alternative. A total of 27 people recorded their names on the attendance register, not including the public agency representatives listed below. Three comments were submitted via the City's website prior to the meeting after the meeting notice. In addition to verbal comments accepted by the project team at the meeting, eleven written comment forms were completed and submitted at the meeting. Two comments were received via the City website after the meeting. The two-week comment period for this public meeting ended on August 11, 2021. While comments will continue to be accepted regarding the project, comments received before August 11, 2021 were to be included in the record of this public meeting.

Following is an overview of comments received.

### Preference for Particular Alternative

- Based on verbal and written comments received, approximately 20 commenters expressed a preference for one or more of the three alternatives presented. Of the 20, approximately 63% favored the Two-Way Cycle Track, 26% favored the Shared-Use Sidepath, and 11% favored the On-Street Bike Lanes.

- Reasons provided for preferring a particular alternative:
  - Two-Way Cycle Track
    - Two commenters suggested this would do the most to encourage cycling and make people feel safe.
    - One commenter liked the fact that pedestrians and cyclists would be separated, and liked the raised median to separate bikes from vehicles.
    - One commenter noted this does not use up green parkway space.
    - One commenter noted that this reduces the need for users to unnecessarily cross Church Street.
  - Sidepath
    - One commenter suggested this would be the best to protect pedestrians and student bikers.
    - Two commenters suggested this is a good option provided there is enough space for all users and pedestrians stay to the right.
    - One commenter felt that the other alternatives will complicate circulation especially during High School arrival and dismissal periods.
  - On-Street Bike Lanes
    - One commenter suggested this alternative would match what Skokie is doing on Church Street west of McCormick.
    - One commenter suggested this is relatively inexpensive and does not use up green parkway space.

#### Regarding the North-South corridor between Harbert Park and Beck Park

- Several commenters liked the preferred N-S corridor that was shown between the North Shore Channel and the District 65 property versus the routes that zig-zag through the neighborhood.
- Two commenters noted attention needs to be given to crossings at Church and Dempster.
- One commenter suggested the path should be continued north into Beck Park to connect to the trail to the north.
- One commenter suggested a two-way bike route on McDaniel between Church and Lake.
- One commenter suggested the southerly end of the N-S trail as shown would be better if placed closer to the Channel.

#### Other Comments/Themes

- Several commenters expressed a desire for better connections across the bridges to the N-S trail in Skokie on the west side of the North Shore Channel.
- Several commenters appreciated plans for bump-outs to reduce pedestrian crossing distances.
- Some comments regarding high vehicle speeds on Church.

# Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements

## Church Street, Dodge Avenue to North Shore Channel

North-South Corridor, Harbert Park to Beck Park



- Some commenters noted a tractor/semi-trailer parks on the south side of Church west of Pitner.
- Two commenters suggested bike facilities should be placed on another route with less car traffic.
- Two commenters suggested that the project limits should extend from the North Shore Channel to downtown and the lakefront.
- Two commenters looked forward to a traffic signal at Pitner and suggested they should be actuated.
- Two comments requesting more traffic signals at the intersections along Church.
- One commenter discussed the congestion at the Dodge intersection.
- One commenter felt that there should be a direct connection to the Green Bay Trail and also to a future light watercraft boat ramp at the channel.
- One commenter expressed a desire for a better crossing at Emerson.
- One commenter suggested bike lanes should be extended north of Church along Dodge.
- One commenter requested better shoveling of the Church Street bridge sidewalks over the North Shore Channel.
- One commenter requested any measures to reduce traffic volumes and speeds on Church would be good.
- The High School representative noted that if the sidepath is the preferred alternative and land from the school is needed, attention will need to be given to drainage.
- Most or all of the attendees expressed appreciation for the meeting and excitement that that work will be done to improve pedestrian and bicyclist mobility, access, and safety.

Phase I includes extensive environmental and design studies and is described in the schedule on the back of this brochure. After a preliminary improvement plan is approved, Phase II Engineering (Contract Plans) and Right-of-Way Acquisition/Temporary Easement Coordination would begin. During this phase, detailed construction plans would be developed and any necessary land would be acquired for the project. Temporary easements for construction access and grading will be necessary and are currently being evaluated and will be presented at the next public meeting. Phase III is the physical construction of the project.

Federal funding will be used by the City of Evanston for the construction of the project.
