2025 Water Main Improvements and Street Resurfacing Project

May 5, 2025

Project Description

Over the next seven months, water main improvements will be taking place at the following six locations listed below and shown on the attached map:

- Ashland Avenue from Lyons Street to Emerson Street
- Darrow Avenue from Lee Street to Dempster Street
- Dewey Avenue from Foster Street to Simpson Street
- McDaniel Avenue from Church Street to Leland Avenue
- Park Place from McDaniel Avenue to Walnut Avenue
- Woodbine Avenue from Livingston Street to Isabella Street

This work involves replacement of deteriorated water mains, water service line replacement, minor sewer improvements, concrete curb and sidewalk repairs, as needed, trench patching, street resurfacing, and parkway restoration. This project will also include the replacement of lead service lines into the homes of participating property owners that have signed a right-of-entry form. If a property owner has declined to participate, the water service line will be replaced up to the parkway and a waiver will be requested.

Project Schedule

The project is anticipated to begin the week of May 12 and be completed in mid-November. Work at each location is expected to last approximately eight to ten weeks. The exact dates of construction

activities scheduled to begin will be noted on the temporary construction zone “No Parking” signs posted a minimum of 48 hours in advance of the work. Parking will be prohibited during daytime work hours (7:00 AM to 5:00 PM) while construction takes place. Street sweeping parking restrictions will be waived for a one block radius around the construction zone when temporary daytime no parking is in effect. Every effort will be made to complete the work in a timely manner to minimize any inconveniences caused by the construction.

Property owners who have a signed right-of-entry form will be contacted by a representative of the contractor to schedule the lead service line replacement to the home once work commences on the block.
