Transit Stop Improvements (Various Locations)

July 17, 2026

Description

As part of the 2026 Downtown Sidewalk and Gap Infill Improvements Project, construction of transit stop improvements is expected to begin in the coming weeks and is anticipated to take approximately four to six weeks to complete. The project includes the installation of ADA-compliant concrete boarding pads at transit stops along Church Street between Florence Avenue and Oak Avenue; Oak Avenue between Davis Street and Dempster Street; Dodge Avenue between Greenleaf Street and Crain Street; Davis Street between Oak Avenue and Asbury Avenue, as shown on the attached project map. These improvements are intended to enhance accessibility, improve pedestrian safety, and provide more convenient access to public transportation for all users. A map identifying the project locations is included with this newsletter for reference.

Schedule

Work is anticipated to begin early August and continue for approximately four to six weeks, weather permitting. Every effort will be made to complete the work in a timely manner to minimize inconveniences caused by construction.
