A RESOLUTION

Authorizing the City Manager to Sign a Resolution for Improvement by Municipality for the resurfacing of Dodge Avenue from Oakton Street to Lee Street

WHEREAS, a goal of the City of Evanston is to provide safe transportation infrastructure within City confines; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and insure public safety, the City seeks to improve City streets by curb replacement, base repair, drainage and utility structure adjustments, and resurfacing of Dodge Avenue from Oakton Street to Lee Street, all within the City, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the improvements to Dodge Avenue will include grinding/milling the street surface, base repair, adjustment of drainage/utility structures, and resurfacing the street with any necessary incidental construction; and

WHEREAS, toward the purpose of this project, the City is to receive an appropriation of funds from the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") in the amount of \$300,000.00 (Three Hundred Thousand and no/100 Dollars) from the City's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds; and

WHEREAS, to receive the allocation from IDOT, it is necessary for the City Manager to execute a Resolution for Improvement by Municipality under the Illinois Highway Code, appropriating \$300,000.00 (Three Hundred Thousand and no/100 Dollars) for the referenced improvements (the "Resolution"), the Resolution is attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Evanston has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Evanston to execute said Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign and the City Clerk authorized and directed to attest on behalf of the City the Resolution for Improvement by Municipality under the Illinois Highway Code, attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate any additional conditions of the Resolution as may be determined to be in the best interests of the City.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution 17-R-11 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
