Mayor Tisdahl called the meeting to order at 9:35 pm.

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING

Mr. Farrar stated they made an offer off the record with the Fire Union today, and made it clear the offer would expire today and we have not heard from them. There is a 2-2-5 split on the wage for the first and second years of the two year contract, but they proposed a 10% salary schedule and a health savings account. The Union does not want to go to arbitration. He stated the City is scheduled for arbitration on June 1st if they do not respond next week we will go into arbitration on Friday.

Mr. Bobkiewicz stated there were no further discussions with AFSME, and that nothing will happen until we have completed negotiations with the Fire Union.

WORKER'S COMPENSATION

Mr. Gustafson presented two (2) cases for discussion and direction and they were:

- (1) Enjoli Daley is a Police Officer with the City of Evanston in the Police Department and is still employed. The requested settlement was in the amount of \$15,544.03, which was approved by the Executive Committee.
- (2) Christopher Tamburrino is a Police Officer with the City of Evanston. The suggested and requested price to close out this case is in the amount of \$52,809.71, and to begin at the lowest reasonable dollar amount without going over the requested amount.

PERSONNEL

Mr. Bobkiewicz stated his concerns of the evening's events involving Mr. Farrar, and the verbal and physical abuse he received from Mr. Kevin O'Connor. He felt it necessary to put Mr. O'Connor on notice for putting his hands on a City employee. He also stated that
