- What policies will provide the longest term reductions?
- How can individual initiatives be joined together to achieve more than one goal?
- Who is the responsible party or agent?
- What are the constraints and/or barriers?
- How can phasing be used to allow increased success of future policies?

1. Submit draft recommendations to staff (end of June)
  - Including preliminary review by the Mayor
2. Staff provide comments back to CARP (prior to July mtg.)
3. CARP revises based on staff comments (July mtg.)
4. Release draft plan for comment (Open all of August)
5. CARP reviews comments and revises (September)
6. Plan revised and submitted to City Council (October)
