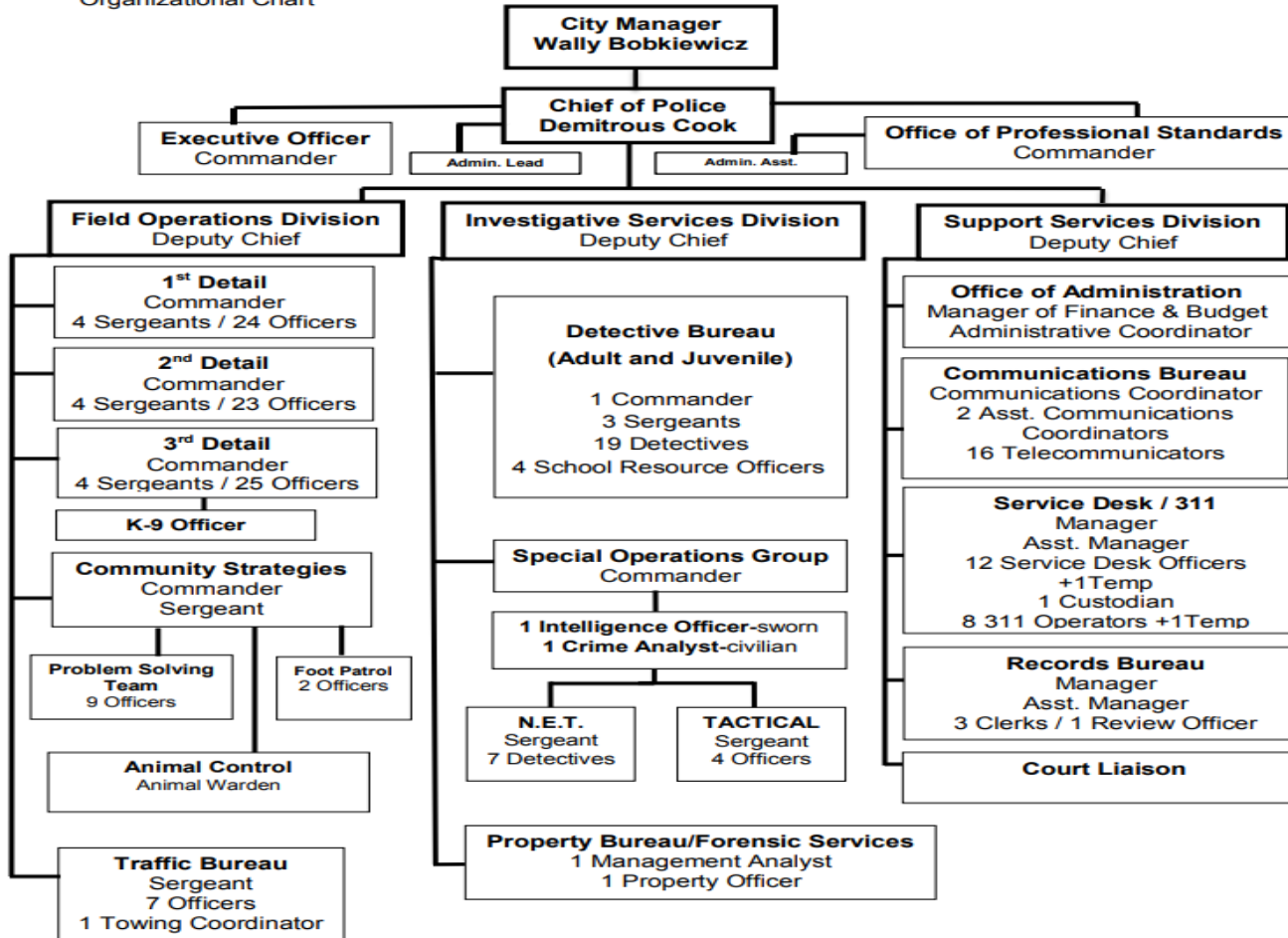

## OFFICE OF PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

**COMPLAINT REGISTER (CR)** are allegations of misconduct by a member of the department.

Of 86,934 CAD events in 2018, OPS investigated 3 CR's.

- 1 Excessive Force complaint pending disposition(still under investigation or administrative review)
- 1 Excessive Force complaint withdrawn (complainant withdrew complaint)
- 1 Biased Based/Harassment complaint pending disposition

## OFFICE OF PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

**DEPARTMENTAL INQUIRY(DI)** are complaints that are minor in nature. DI's are handled by first line supervisor, then submitted through the chain of command to the Chief of Police, who makes the final determination.

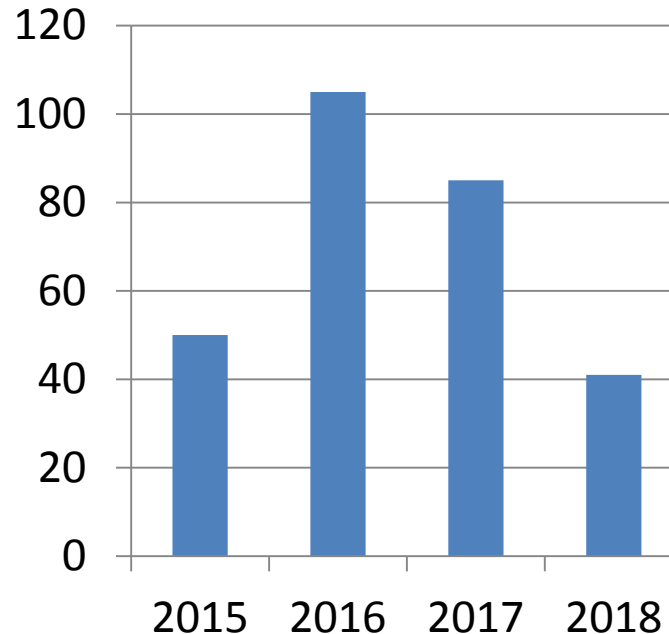
