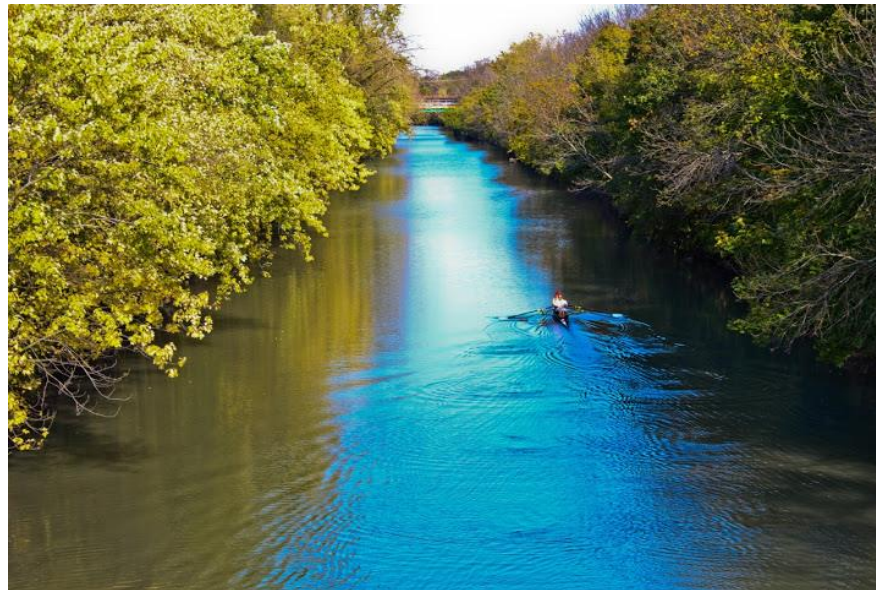

TENANT-BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE

- **Funded by City's HOME grant from HUD**
- **Strategy in 2009 Housing Plan & 2014-2019 Consolidated Plan**
- **Housing stability for homeless families with children in schools (McKinney-Vento families)**
- **Funds allocated in 2013, 2016, 2017 & 2018**
- **To date HOME for TBRA = \$1,300,000**
- **Connections for the Homeless is subrecipient**
- **Application to HHC, P&D/City Council**
- **2019 application on September 9 agenda**

TENANT-BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE

- **TBRA funds 24-month rent & utilities subsidy**
- **Connections leverages \$ for case management & other services**
- **Between July 1, 2018 and July 1, 2019:**
 - 26 families; 30 adults & 72 children
 - 10 families exited to permanent housing
 - 22 families got/maintained living wage jobs
 - 12 families increased their income
 - 98% of children advanced to the next grade
- **Average 20 families served each year**
