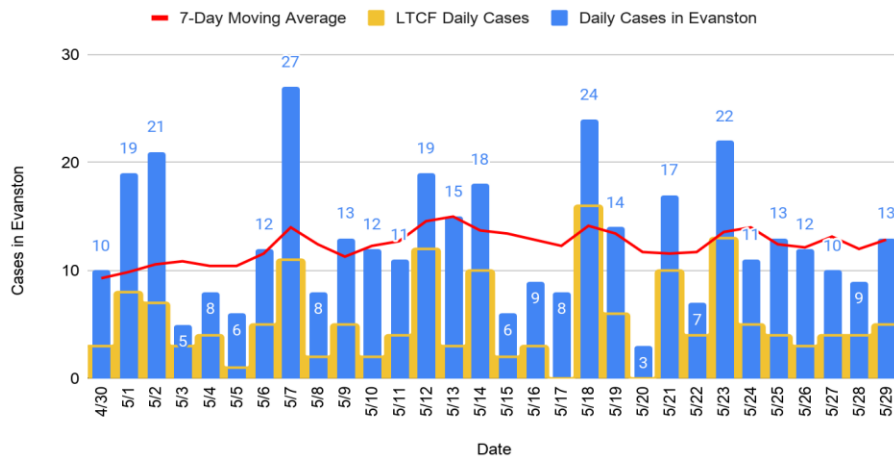
Good evening,

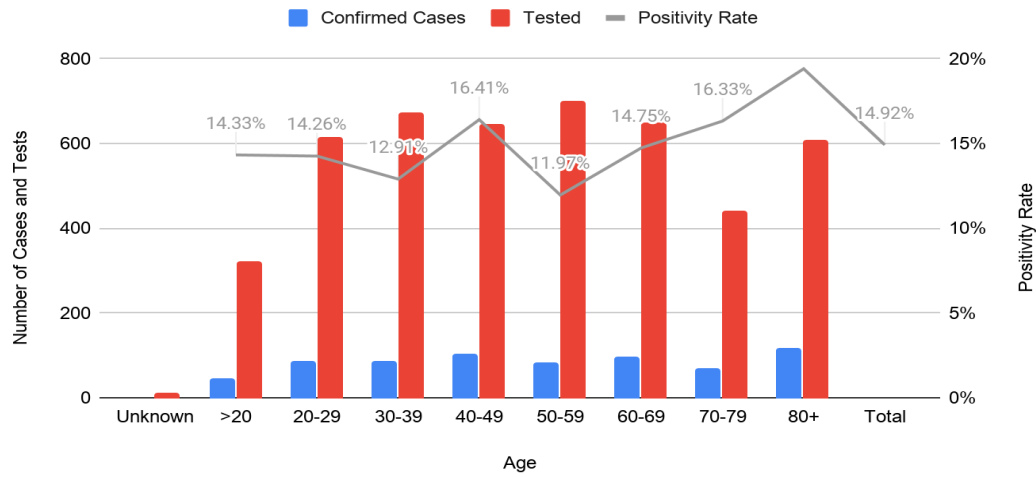
The Illinois five-phased plan will reopen our state, guided by health metrics and with distinct business, education, and recreation activities characterizing each phase

Strict stay at home and social distancing guidelines are in place, and only essential businesses remain open.	Non-essential retail stores reopen for curb-side pick-up and delivery.	Manufacturing, offices, barbershops and salons can reopen to the public with capacity and other limits, and safety precautions.	Gatherings of 50 people or fewer are allowed, restaurants and bars reopen, travel resumes, child care and schools reopen under guidance of IDPH.	The economy fully reopens with safety precautions continuing.

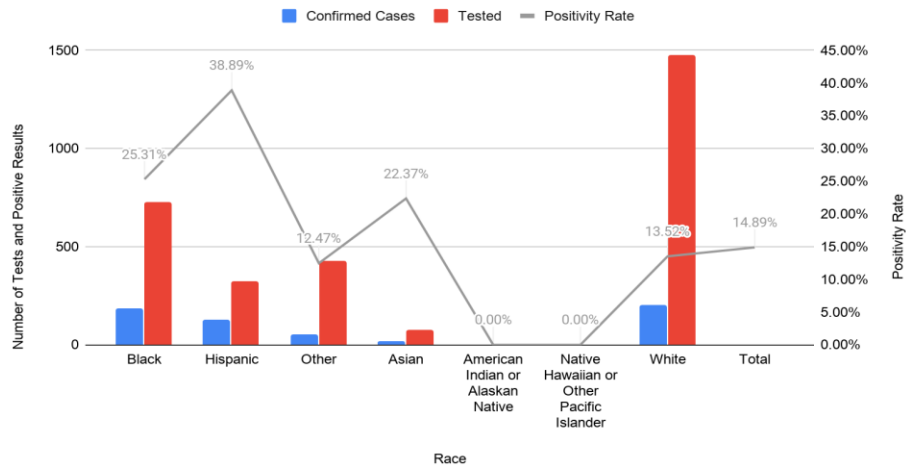
Confirmed Daily Cases in Evanston (Last 30 days)
